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1 A A-hum.

2 Q And you settled that case with Frank Frisoli?

3 A Is it settled?

4 Q I'm asking you.

5 A I don't know if it is or not.

6 Q What is it that you recall were the  
7 circumstances of resolving the Middlesex case?

8 A What I recall is that I was put on the witness  
9 stand. They sent me a check saying I had to  
10 show up for \$12.60. I went there not knowing  
11 or understanding it all. They asked me our  
12 age difference then he hit me with, "Is this  
13 your signature on the deed?" I said, "It's  
14 not," and they said, "It's not?" I said,  
15 "No."

16 I think that was on a Tuesday and at  
17 the end of that day they said that Liza Daniel  
18 was going to be on the stand the next day and  
19 Frank Frisoli approached me and said, you  
20 know, on Monday of that week he offered  
21 \$100,000 if I would take my name off the deed.  
22 Then by Wednesday morning he had increased it  
23 to \$250,000 and he said the trial can all be  
24 over and my attorney was telling me his

1 thoughts on the whole thing at that point.

2 MR. BROWN: I don't want you to talk  
3 about our conversations. Any conversations  
4 with me are privileged.

5 A And so what I remember about it is I signed  
6 some paperwork and all hell broke loose in the  
7 courtroom about being taken advantage off and  
8 so forth and I'm not smart enough to know  
9 what's going on.

10 Q When you say all hell broke loose in the  
11 courtroom, what are you talking about?

12 A Ms. Daniel was extremely upset that the  
13 tenants of entirety was something that we had  
14 to talk about together to decide to sell the  
15 house together as an agreed upon situation.  
16 Frank Frisoli made the deal and said, "If you  
17 sign it this trial is over." So I looked at  
18 it at the time like well, I saved Liza having  
19 to go through this again and so it ended and  
20 that's it.

21 Q What is your understanding of the deal that  
22 you made with Frisoli -- do you know what the  
23 details of that deal are?

24 A The detail is there's still a \$13 million
